About CPMI

- As part of the One Belt One Road initiative, College of Underwater Acoustic Engineering, Harbin Engineering University (HEU), China, is organizing and sponsoring China Pakistan Marine Information (CPMI) workshop for the last three years. The workshop aims to strengthen the scientific and research collaboration between China and Pakistan in the field of Marine Information. Every year leading researchers in the field of marine information and technology are invited from both academia and industry to share their expertise. The workshop is attended by hundreds of participants each year from both China and Pakistan and has gained significant attention in the marine research community.

CPMI-2022 (this year marks the fourth workshop) will be held in parallel at HEU (China), and COMSATS

- University Islamabad (CUI) - Wah Campus (Pakistan) on November 16, 2022 where speakers and participants from China and Pakistan will attend the workshop in their respective country.

On the Chinese side, this year the workshop is supported by China Association for Science and Technology

- along with National Key lab and Heilongjiang Key lab of marine information and technology. From Pakistan side, three important related departments of Ministry of Science and Technology i.e. National Institute of Oceanography (NIO), Pakistan Science Foundation (PSF), Pakistan Scientific and Technological Information Center (PASTIC) are joining hands with the academic institutes i.e. CUI and FAST-National University of Computer and Emerging Science (NUCES) to promote this emerging area of marine information and technology.

Workshop Goals

- To strengthen the collaboration between HEU and Pakistan experts in field of Marine Information Technology
- To help to build indigenous capacity in Pakistan in the field of Marine Information Technology.
- To enable the students of both China and Pakistan to showcase their talent and get international exposure.

Keynotes and Invited Talks

- Two keynote speeches (one each from Pakistan and China) are also planned this year to highlight the significance and potential of research in marine informatics and technology.
- Experts from academia and industry from both China and Pakistan will participate as invited speakers to discuss the current and future aspects of Marine informatics.

Students Participation and Competition

- In addition to keynotes and invited talks, the workshop also encourages the participation of students to present their work in the form of posters or presentations. The posters will be displayed the entire time during the workshop and judged by the invited speakers. Similarly, a session in parallel will be arranged for students to present their work too.
- An award of 10k PKR will be given to the best presenter and the best poster decided by the committee during the workshop.
